1. How much tutoring will my child need?

The honest answer? We won't know until we've met them. Every child learns differently, and the amount of tutoring they need depends on a mix of factors: where the gaps are, why they're struggling, what their goals are, how quickly they absorb new concepts, and how confident they feel in the subject.

What we can say is this: less is often more. If you're new to tutoring, start with one hour a week and adjust as we go. Most students see real progress with a steady, consistent approach — and we'll help you review and refine the plan as they grow.

2. What if my child doesn't like their assigned tutor?

It happens — and that's okay! Learning is personal, and a good tutor–student match is essential. If the chemistry isn't right, simply drop us a message. We'll switch tutors before the next session, no questions asked. Your child deserves to feel comfortable, supported, and motivated.

3. Do we have to have lessons every week?

Not at all. While regular sessions build confidence and momentum, your schedule and your child's well-being come first. If you need to skip a week, double up another, or pause during exam breaks or holidays, that's absolutely fine. Just let us know, and we'll make it work.
